Role Overview

For the purposes of a one-year project for the World Bank, Tameo is seeking a Survey Enumerator to join our Research unit and contribute to the success of the World Bank Enterprise Survey Switzerland 2025. This role involves conducting face-to-face and/or online interviews with Swiss-based firms across various sectors. You will work closely with our Research team to gather high-quality, standardized data, ensuring consistency and comparability across respondents.

This part-time role is available for 2025 on a one-year contract, with the potential to transition to a permanent position in 2026 based on performance and our expanding operations.

Key Responsibilities

The Survey Enumerator is essential to delivering high-quality survey results and will be responsible for:

- **Participation in training:** Complete initial training (5 days, in Geneva, in January) on survey content and question framing.
- **Pilot survey execution:** Conduct a pilot questionnaire, identifying and documenting data quality gaps with solutions for improvement.
- **Survey administration:** Run a large-scale survey, collecting specific metrics from Swiss-based firms across various regions.
- Data management: Accurately centralize collected data into Tameo's data platform.
- **Reporting:** Regularly update the Research team on survey progress and immediately flag any bottlenecks that could impact deadlines.

Qualifications

- **Experience:** 1-2 years in data collection, research, or survey administration. Experience in impact investing is an advantage.
- Languages: Candidates must be fluent in at least one official Swiss language (two is preferred), along with proficiency in English for team communication and accurate data entry.
- Availability: Flexible availability, ranging from 40-60% throughout 2025. A one-year contract with potential for a permanent role based on performance.
- Technical skills: Familiarity with data collection tools or applications is an asset.
- Work environment: Access to a personal laptop/computer with a stable internet connection and willingness to travel within Switzerland.
- **Location:** This remote role requires the applicant to be based in Switzerland. Proficiency in one of the local languages (French, German, Italian) is essential.
